Heavenly Wisdom

It is easier for us to judge what we see. That is one of the reasons we do not make good judges and God does not appoint us as such. We do not see people's hearts or motives behind what they do. Thankfully, Judging is left up to Jesus who sees the whole picture.

Since we only see a sliver of people's lives, and that which is visible, we tend to place a lot of weight on those visible things. We in turn tend to make those things the priorities in our lives because that is how we see others. What about those things that are not easily seen; those traits and characteristics that are more like attitudes and spiritual ways of thinking? I think we have the tendency to downplay these things and the role they play in our lives. However, James uses some strong words when it comes to a spiritual way of thinking we ought to possess. I would like for you to reflect on these words from James. See if you feel the weight of what he is saying as I did when I read through this today.

[13] Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom. [14] But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. [15] This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. [16] For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work. [17] But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. [18] And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace. (James 3:13-18)


