
- The emphasis that this writing is clearly divinely inspired.
- At least ten different reasons for commending the Thessalonians
- Personal greetings of significance.

Interesting Facts

- 1 Thessalonians has 5 chapters, 89 verses, 1979 words, and can be read by the average reader in about 12 minutes.
- Written by Paul from Corinth in the Spring of AD 50 as the first epistle written unless Galatians was written earlier.
- The first epistle share the theme of the second coming of Christ and emphasizes that the coming is for the reward of the redeemed
- Pau wrote the epistle in response to Timothy's good report of their faith and love.
- The letter is characterized by simplicity, gentleness, and affection.
- Each of its five chapters ends on the note of Christ's second coming.
- One short passage (5:14-22) contains fifteen exhortations.
- There is no Old Testament quotation in the epistle.
