### Scheme of Redemption

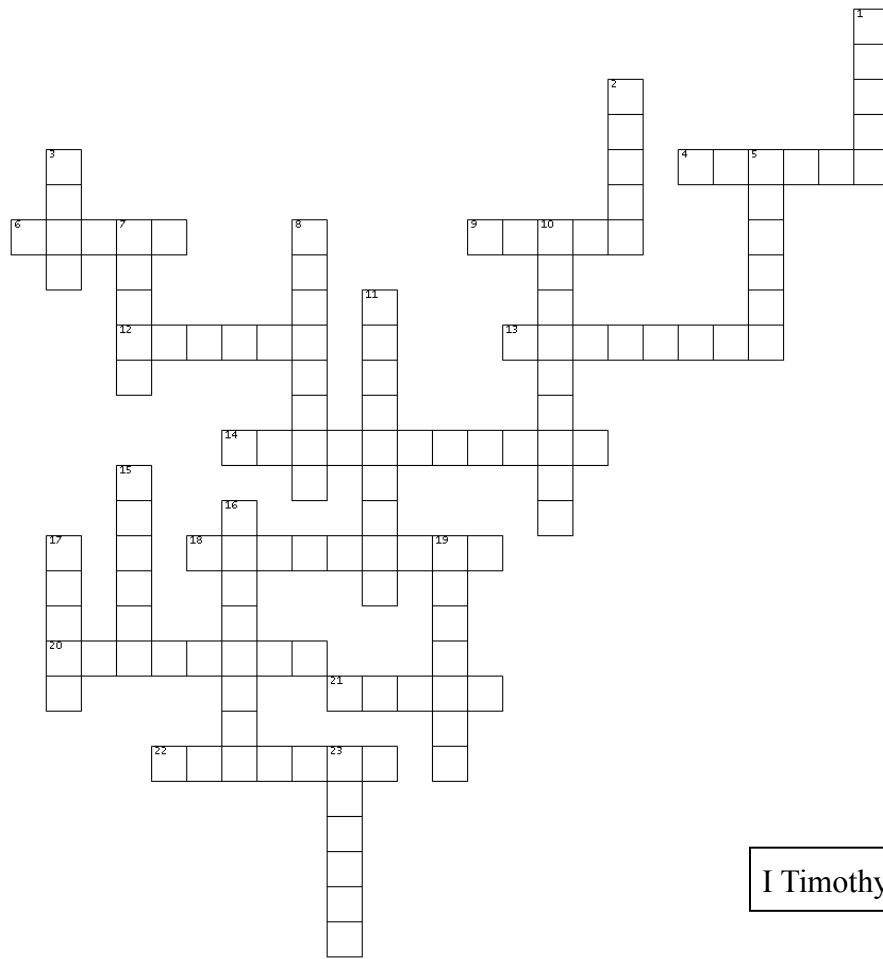
A Challenge to the Redeemed to Teach No Other Doctrine
