Interesting Facts

- ❖ Acts has 28 chapters, 1007 verses, 24,229 words and can be read in 2 hours and 15 minutes.
- ❖ Written by Luke and it is an extension of the gospel account to its practical application of mission.
- ❖ As Genesis was the book of physical beginnings, Acts is the book of spiritual beginnings.
- ❖ The “we” passages of Acts show it’s author Luke to have accompanied him to Rome and he probably wrote the book from there while Paul was still in prison.
- ❖ A study of the cases of conversion will show baptism as essential to salvation. There is no conversion case without baptism and there is no conversion case that includes “the sinner’s prayer.”
- ❖ Acts is Action packed.

The Preaching of Redemption from Jerusalem to Rome

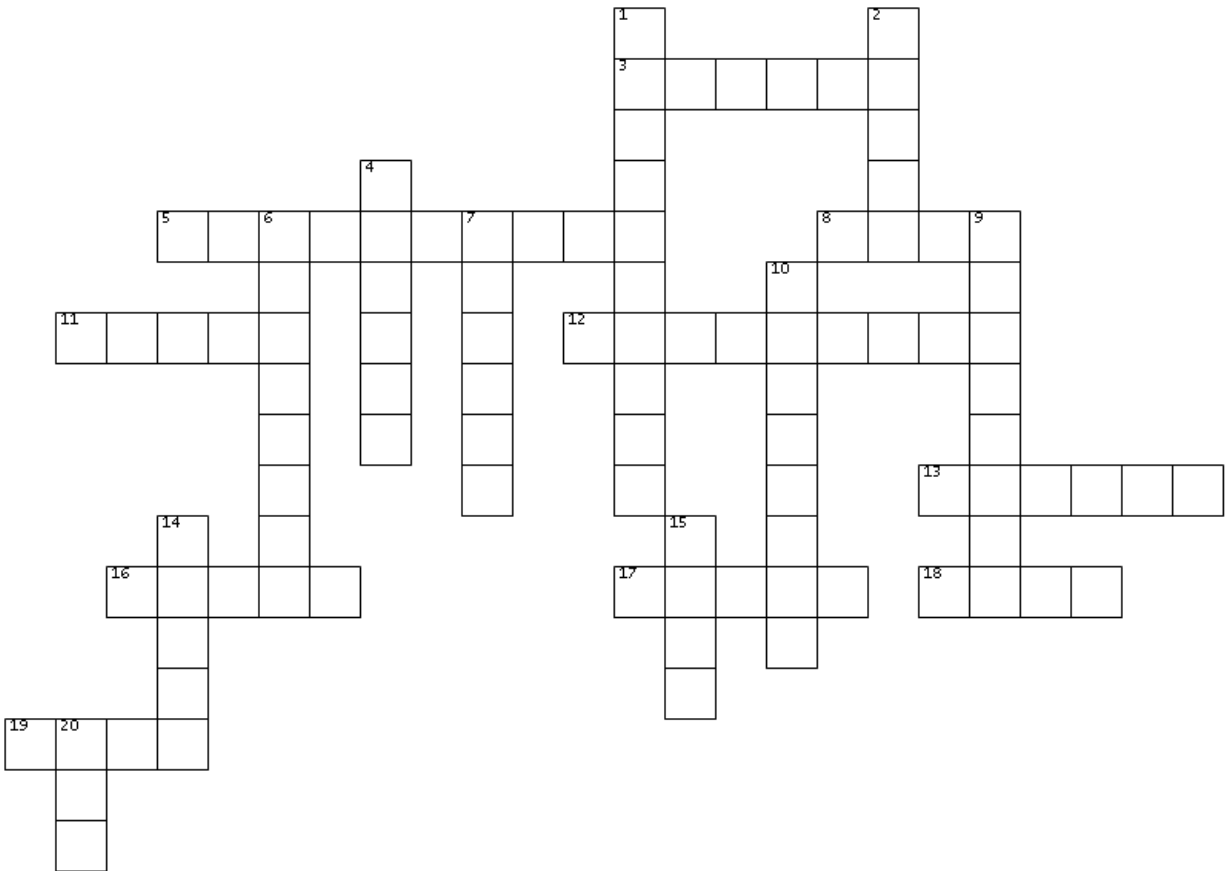
