Memorable Outline of Ecclesiastes

- I. Introduction and author (ch. 1)
- II. Life experiment to find meaning and purpose (chs. 2 -4)
- III. General proverbs (chs. 5 8:14)
- IV. Inevitability of death calls for enjoyment of life (chs. 8:15 9)
- V. More general proverbs and conclusion (10 -12)

What to look for as you read:

- 1. The meaning of "Life under the sun"
- 2. The identity of the author
- Song lyrics to "Turn!
 Turn! Turn!" by the Byrds
- Challenging verses to understand (unusual metaphors, apparent conflict with usual Biblical thought, and bright spots in an otherwise bleak outlook)
- A resolve to the vainity of life

Interesting Facts:

- The book was written by Qoheleth, preacher, teacher and is commonly identified as Solomon (1:1 & 16).
- The title Ecclesiastes comes from transliteration of the Greek translation of Qoheleth.
- The word "vanity" occurs 37 times and the phrase "under the sun," occurs 29 times.
- Powerful sarcasm seen in 11:9.
- Poetic description of "the water cycle" unknown scientifically at the time (1:6-7).
- Ecclesiastes has 12 chapters, 222 verses, 5,579 words, and can be read in 30 minutes.


