- ❖ Written by Moses in the Hebrew about 1500 BC
- ❖ The name "Genesis" comes from a Greek word meaning "beginning" and the first word of the book in the Hebrew is "berisis" meaning "beginning."
- ❖ A Book of Faith - Background for much of Hebrews 11, Abraham father of the faithful, Noah, and Enoch
- ❖ Foundational to the idea of covenant
- ❖ Genesis has 50 chs., 1533 vss., and 38,262 wds. It can be read by the average reader in 3.5 hours.
