Interesting Facts

- ❖ Jeremiah was called to be a prophet around 625 BC as a young man.
- ❖ The book contains many dating markers, begins with Jeremiah's call to prophecy and ends with the destruction of Jerusalem but does not progress chronologically.
- ❖ The writing of the book was completed some 50 years later after the destruction of Jerusalem by Nebuchadnezzar.
- ❖ Jeremiah has 52 chapters, 1364 verses, 42654 words, and can be read in about 4 hours.

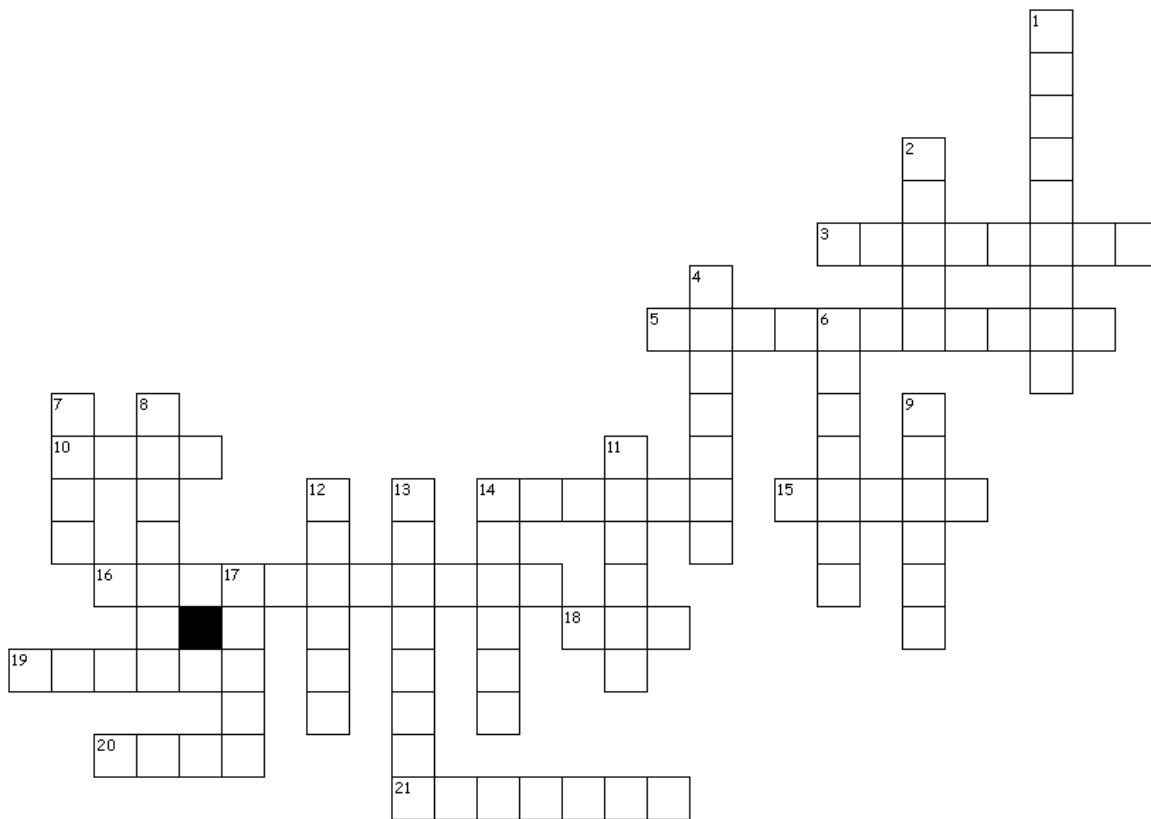
