Interesting Facts


- Authorship is most likely unknown although it could have been written by Job, who was a real person (Ezekiel 14:14, James 5:11).

- Victor Hugo said, "The book of Job is perhaps the greatest masterpiece of the human mind." Tennyson called it "the greatest poem, whether of ancient or modern literature."
- The book of Job "has been called a key to the whole Bible, and to man's history from creation to completed redemption.
- Job has 42 chapters, 1,070 verses, 18,098 words and can be read in about 1 hour and 45 minutes
