Interesting Facts

- ❖ John has 21 chapters, 879 verses, 18,658 words, and can be read in about 2 hours.
- ❖ Of Redemption... Luke gives the time, 2:1; Matthew the place, 2; John the form 1:14; Mark the meaning, 1:1.
- ❖ Matthew to Jews, Mark to the Romans, Luke to the Greeks and John to everyone.
- ❖ Written by John between 70 and 90 A.D. Irenaeus, the pupil of Polycarp who was a friend and pupil of John, says he wrote the gospel from Ephesus, "sixty years after the Ascension."
- ❖ Gospel of great teaching to individuals: Nicodemus, ch. 3; Samaritan woman, ch. 4; the woman taken in adultery, ch. 8; words of Jesus from the cross to people around it ch. 19.
- ❖ Lengthy instruction on the vine and branches, sheepfold, unity, holy spirit.
- ❖ Fellowship, life, light and love

The Reasonableness of the Faith of the Redeemed

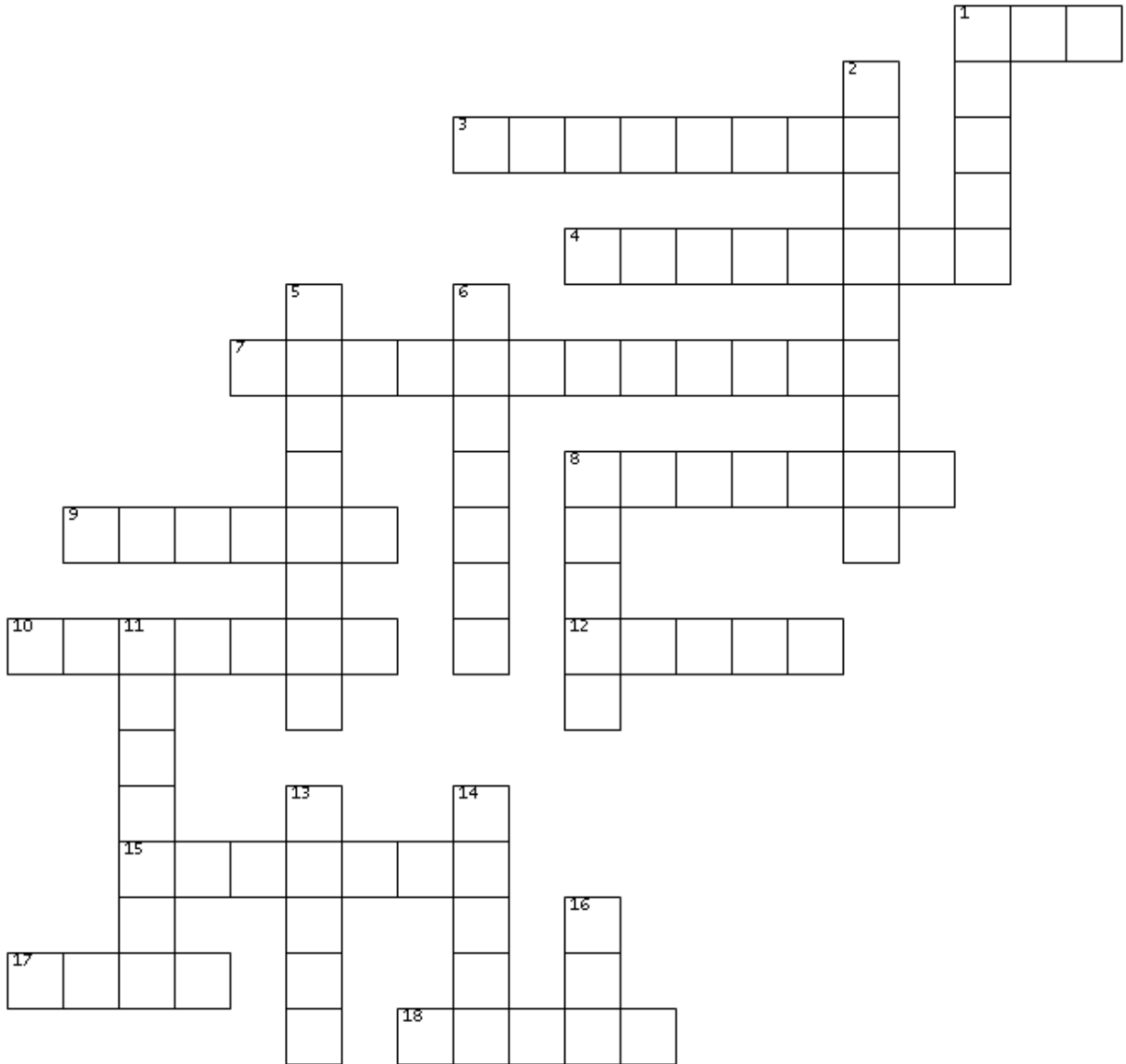
