- I. Introduction (1:1-4)
- II. An account of the time preceding Christ's public ministry giving information not found in the other Gospels (1:5-2:52).
- III. The Galilean Ministry, in which is to be found much material in common with Matthew and Mark (3:1-9:50).
- IV. The last journeys to Jerusalem, giving matter principally peculiar to Luke alone (9:51-18:14).
- V. Events relating to the sufferings, death, resurrection of the Savior (18:15-24:53).



- Luke according to the first three verses searched out those things believed among them and wrote them in order.
- Luke gives an account of great beauty, accuracy and precise detail.
- It is a more complete biography of Christ than other accounts.
- It is a gospel of womanhood and childhood.
- It is a gospel of the poor and outcasts.
- It is a gospel of song and praise.
- It is a gospel of prayer.
- The gospel account of Luke contains 24 chapters, 1,151 verses, 25,540 words, and can be read in about 2.5 hours.
