- ❖ Written by Moses in the Hebrew about 1500 BC
- ❖ The name “Numbers” refers to the two counts of Israel. The Hebrew title “In the Wilderness” best names the whole book.
- ❖ It covers 40 years from the preparation for war, march to Canaan, spies, disbelief, punishment & return to Canaan
- ❖ The sad story can be written in 3 words: discontent, disaster, and discipline.
- ❖ Numbers has 36 chs. 1289 verses 328096 words and can be read in 3 hours.

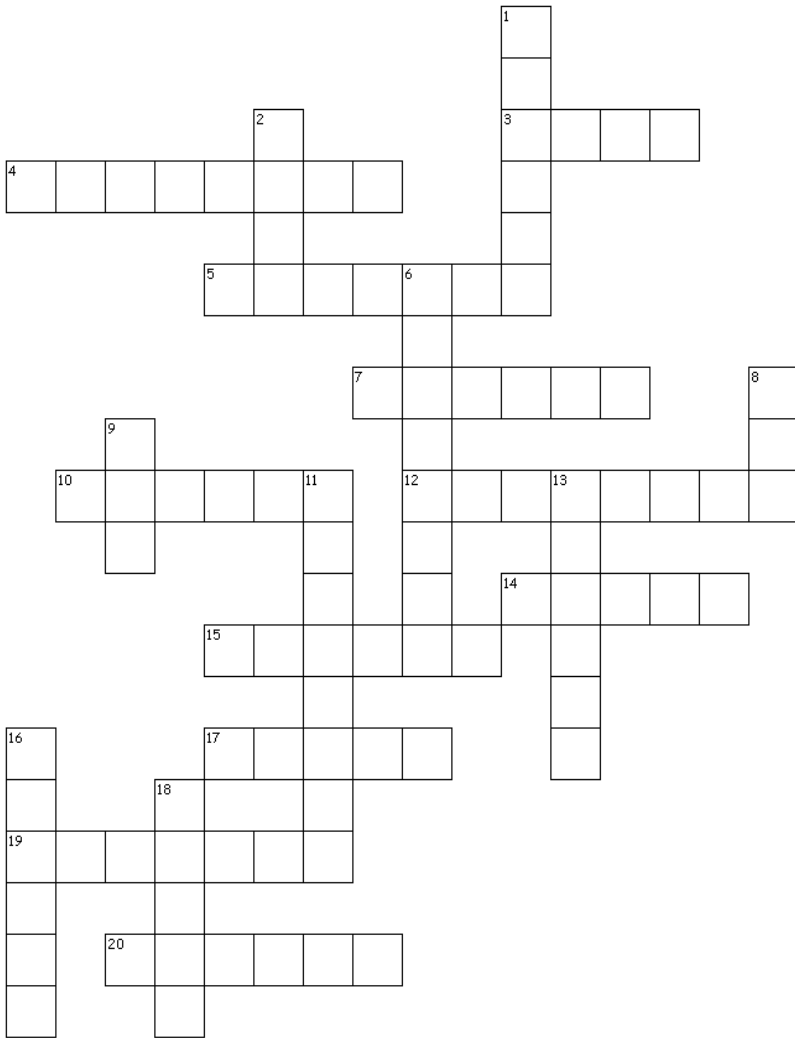
