- Notice the positive upbeat nature of the book.
- Paul's outlook on life generally remembering that he is in prison at the time ot this writing.
- Paul's confidence in the Philippians

#### Interesting Facts

- Philippians is 4 chapters, 104 verses, 2183 words and can be read by the average reader in 14 minutes.
- Written by Paul from Rome in about 61 AD.
- With a theme of Cristian joy some form of the words joy and rejoice occur 17 times in this short epistle.
- Philippians had a great relationship with the apostle Paul.
- One of four prison epistles written by Paul from Rome.
