## Interesting Facts

- ❖ Solomon wrote most of them (1:1; 25:1). These are only a part of the 3,000 proverbs the Solomon wrote (1 Kings 4:32)
- ❖ Solomon was a good teacher but a poor example. In his latter years he did not walk in the way of wisdom. His son, Rehoboam, followed his example rather than his counsels, and became a foolish and evil ruler.
- ❖ The book of Proverbs covers a wide range of subjects. Many human experiences are reflected in these proverbs, such as care, joy, feebleness, sorrow and so on.
- ❖ Proverbs has 31 chapters, 915 verses, 15,038 words and can be read in about 1 hour and 30 minutes.

## Scheme of Redemption The Wisdom of the Redeemed

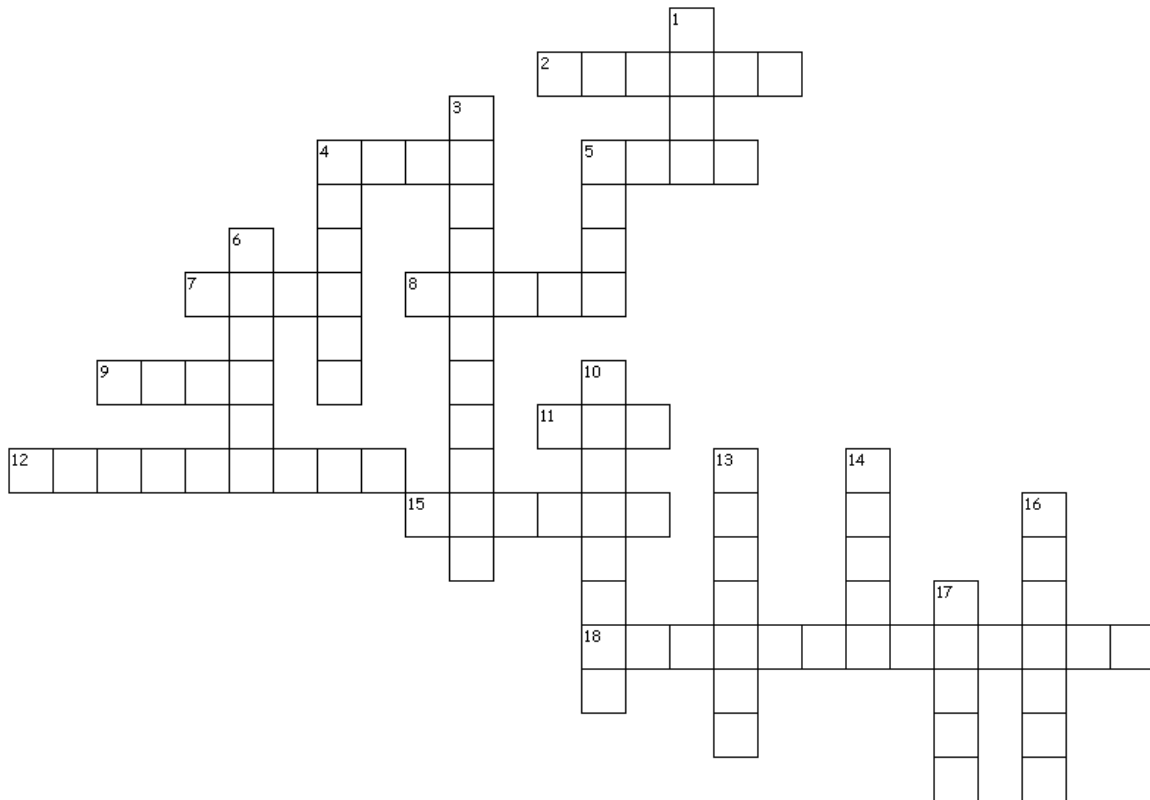
“The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.” (9:10)
