- ❖ Great doctrines: Righteousness, Justification, Election, and Sanctification.
- ❖ Romans chapter 12 has been called “The Little Bible.”
- ❖ Romans chapter 16 was the text of one of the best sermons I (LEM) have ever heard, delivered by the late Wayne Coats.

- **See the fellowship of fellow laborers in chapter 16.**

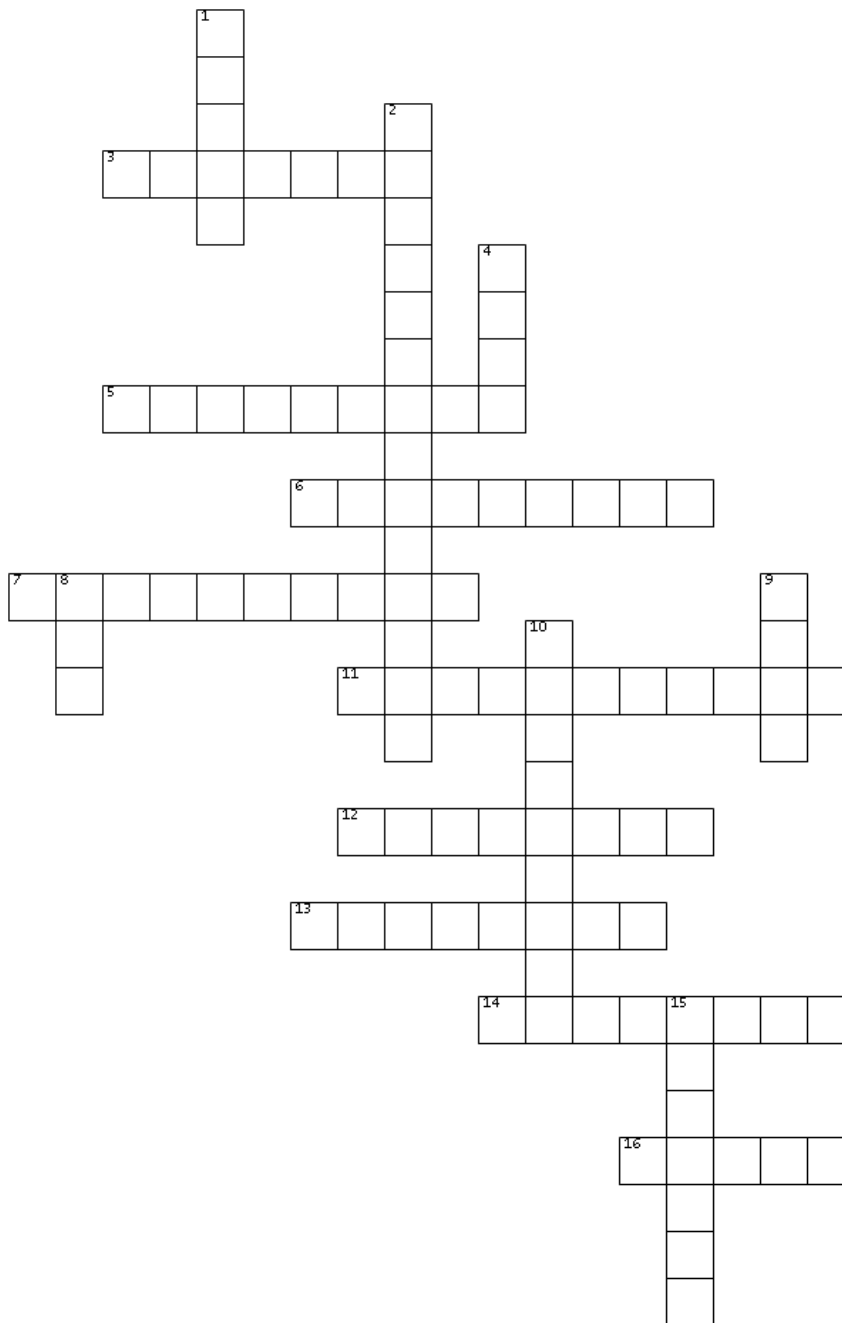
