### Interesting Facts


- The northern kingdom of Israel is virtually ignored in 2 Chronicles.
- The book covers about 430 years, from the reign of Solomon to Babylonian captivity.
- Five periods of reformation recorded in 2 Chronicles under Kings Asa, Jehoshaphat, Joash, Hezekiah, and Josiah.
- 2 Chronicles has 36, chapters 822 verses, 26,069 words, and can be read in about 2 hours and 30 minutes.
