## Interesting Facts

- ❖ It bears the name of Samuel because of his place and influence during this period. 2 Samuel covers the time of David's reign (1055-1015 B.C.)
- ❖ David ranks with Abraham and Moses as one of the three "mountain peaks" of the O.T. He stands halfway between Abraham and Christ, about 1,000 years from each.
- ❖ David's two greatest accomplishments were the kingdom and the Psalms. Although he sinned, David served God "with all his heart" (1 Kings 14:8)
- ❖ The book of 2 Samuel contains 24 chapters, 695 verses, 20,600 words and requires about 2 hours to read.

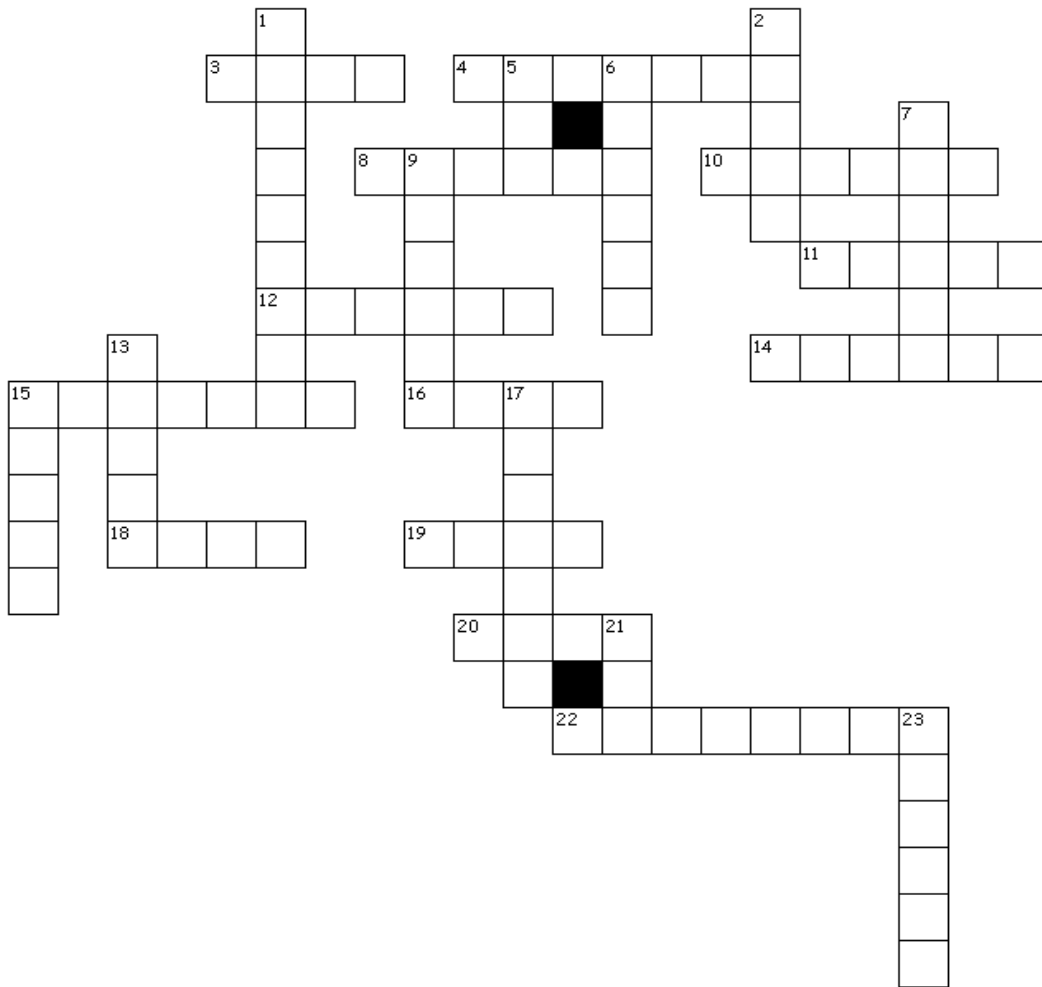
