
Titus Theme: Last Words from "Father" to "Son"




Interesting Facts

 There are 3 chapters, 46 verses, 896 words, and can be read by the average reader in 7 minutes.

- Paul wrote the book to Titus to guide the young evangelist in his work with the church in Crete.
- Paul wrote the book about 66 AD from Nicopolus.
- Titus is mentioned 13 times in Paul's writings.
- Titus is not mentioned in the book of Acts however Paul mentions him in Galatians referring back to the time period covered by Luke in Acts (Gal. 2:1-4)
- Titus was Paul's exhibit A for assurance that a gentile convert did not have to be circumcised (Gal. 2:1-4).
- He may have been from Antioch of Syria.
- Even more than Timothy we are left wishing for more information on his interaction as a working associate and a son in the faith of Paul.
